Being born in village Lindoor in Lahoul & Spiti Distt, to begin with, I had to do mountaineering for my survival. Later on, I got opportunities to trek, explore and climb the highest in the adventure are of the Himalayan and Eastern Karakoram. I have the unique distinctions of having worked in all the mountaineering Institutes in the country. I am probably the only summitter of both the Nanda devi from the country and ONLY SURVIVING summitter of Kanchendzonga from the maiden climb along the most difficult North East Ridge route in May 1977. have crossed over 75 known and unknown high passes in the entire length and breadth of Himalayan and Eastern Karakoram in my more than five decades of high adventure. Have the distinction of having commanded a company of troops in the North most sector – Karakoram pass axis and East Most sector ie the point where Lohit River enters India, Commanded a Battalion in the most famous Logewal sector in Ladakh. Was tasked to final movement and domination of the highest battle ground in the world by the Indian Army.

My trainees include: Ms Bachendri Pal – first women Everest Summitter from India, Ms Dickey Dolma – the youngest women Everest summitter in the world, Ms Deepou Sharama – Everest Summitter, Naib Subedar Amar Praksh: Assam Riles, Everest sum miter from south Col route and from Kangshung Face and Sh Magendra from Malaysia – summitter from Everest in the Malaysian maiden Everest in 1997. I have also carried out some daring search and Rescue Mission during my high adventure along the length and breath of the Himalaya and Eastern Karakoram.

Presently I am deeply involved in supervising and conducting Himalayan OUT DOOR Skill training camps, preservation and conservation of Himalayan flora and fauna and the culture of the people there and helping expeditions visiting HP with technical advice and local liaison and administrative support – thus giving back to the system from where I got so much.
